☐ Casual clothing	☐ Rubber bands
☐ Spare glasses	☐ Zip loc bags
☐ Sleeping bag	☐ Large garbage bags
☐ Sleeping bag liner/sheet	☐ Water purification system
☐ Pillow (compact)	☐ 50 feet rope line (paracord)

☐ Bag identification – remember to ID your bags with your Name and Team. Write this info on the bag or	
with nametapes rather than luggage tags	
☐ Ensure bags weight less than 50 lbs.	
☐ Gear and bags should be able to withstand water
