Q. Do the two extra speakers have to be the same as my present speakers?

A. No. As in any sound system, the better they are, the better the results. But the extra ("rear") speakers can be economy models and still provide the you-are-there realism of 4-channel stereo.

Q. Can I get similar results to 4-channel stereo by just adding two more speakers to my regular stereo system and putting them in the rear of the room?

A. No. This would no more give you 4-channel stereo than connecting two speakers to an ordinary monophonic radio would give you 2-channel stereo sound.

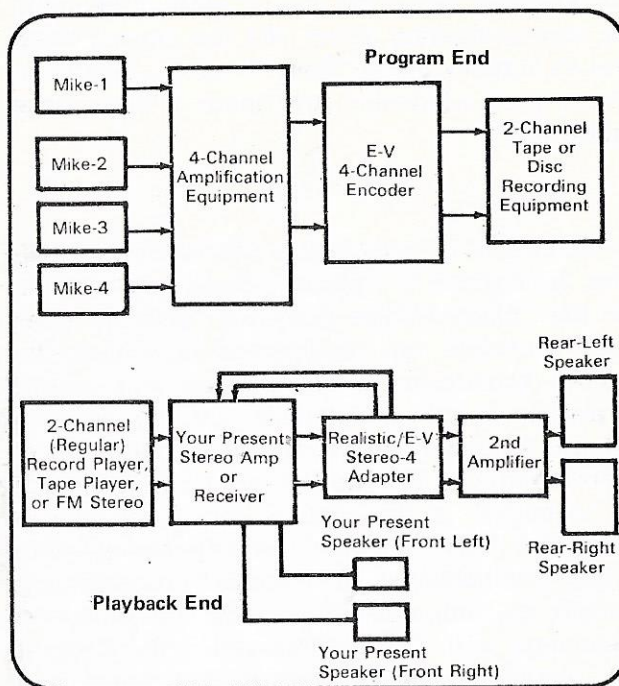
Q. Is your Stereo-4 system really 4-channel sound or a gimmick? I don't see how you can get 4-channel sound from a Stereo-4 record when you use a phono needle designed for ordinary 2-channel stereo and have only two audio cables, one for each channel, coming out of the record player.

A. It's NOT phony and is TRUE 4-channel stereo. A regular stereo phono needle is used, but it picks up *out-of-phase* 4-channel signals on the record, then feeds all this into the two regular audio cables of the player. Then "electronics" takes over and the Stereo-4 adapter separates the two extra channels of *out-of-phase* sound from the other two channels. And you get a total of four different—and genuine—channels.

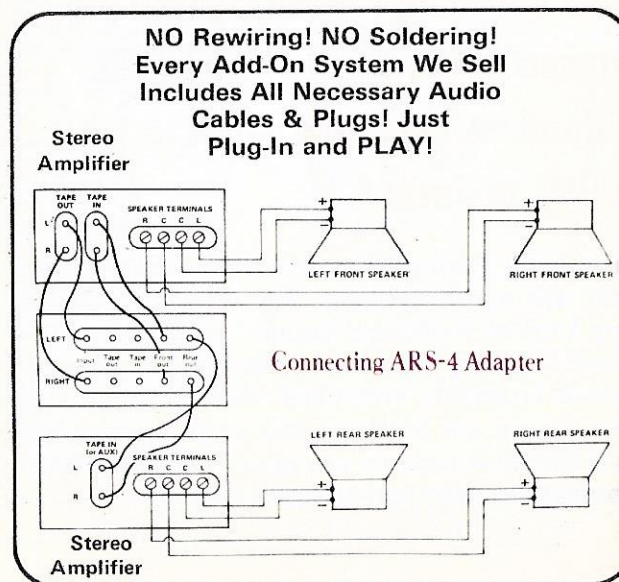
Q. What happens if I play a regular stereo record rather than a special four-channel record?

A. That's up to you. By turning a knob on the Stereo-4 adapter, you can get standard 2-channel stereo out of your two original speakers. However, most people much prefer to leave the two additional speakers and the Stereo-4 adapter in operation because the Stereo-4 circuits are designed to add extra depth and dimension to even regular stereo material.

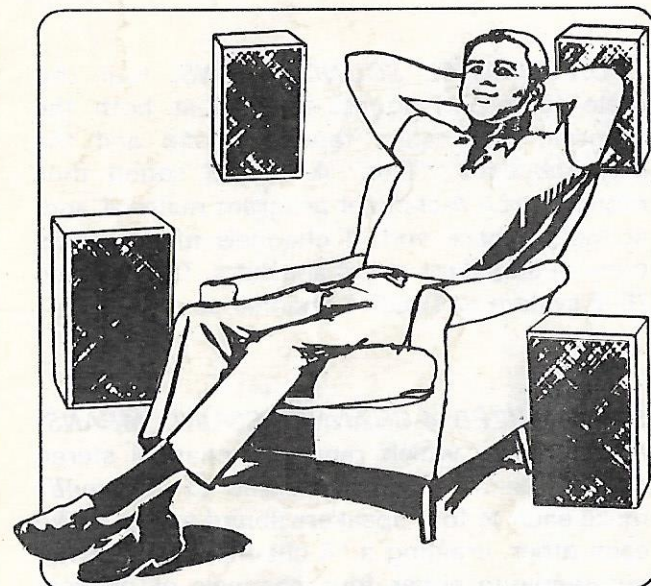
