

In the case of Matrix, there is some combining of signals.

**Q: Is there a practical, discrete 4-channel disc available now?**

A: No. A 4-channel disc system has been developed but it requires complex and expensive playback equipment and cannot be considered practical at this time.

**Q: Is it possible to hear discrete four-channel on FM radio?**

A: No. Four-channel discrete broadcasting is still in the experimental stages.

**Q: Are there any advantages to buying one system over the other?**

A: Yes. The Matrix system offers you a great deal of flexibility and does not obsolete your current equipment or library of records and tapes. The use of the discrete system is limited primarily to 4-channel discrete tape, currently in rather limited supply.

**Q: What are the advantages of the Magnavox Decoder over other decoders?**

A: Low cost and ease of installation. And, most importantly a second amplifier is not required.
